Next spring, city swimming pool regulars can expect to be greeted by a friendly new face. Effective October 17, new city employee Krystal Paige Lomenick will become responsible for the management of Sapulpa's Water Recreational facilities. She will also become the Assistant Director of the Parks and Recreation Department.

The new employee earned her BS degree in Recreation Management from the University of Central Oklahoma (Edmond) and has experience in a variety of health and recreational arenas, including home health, child services, hospital and YMCA activities.
